We are beginning to work on the new dropdown boxes for program/county consistency.

The FP dropdown box (previous page) has been completed.

This is what the nurse will see when she is doing a FP encounter and is choosing the services she is doing.

These will be updated in each county one by one, and **IT will notify your county when they are working on yours, in the next few weeks!**

Please look at this ahead of time, so it will not be a surprise to you!

Discuss it at staff meetings and be sure all clinical staff gets a copy to refer to.

Changes taking place:  
FP DROPDOWN BOX

1. There have been a few changes tweaked with a couple of the codes to be consistent across the board, so please FP nurses, look at the choices.
2. If you order, or refer for a Mammogram, please go to the Lab page and order there also, for tracking purposes and state numbers. There are choices for screening, diagnostic, and additional views. (MAMM-S, MAMM-D, MAMM-AV, ULTRA for breast ultrasound)
3. URIN will be the “no charge urinalysis”, as it was already current for the CH program and can be used for both. If you currently use something else you will need to change to URIN. If you are a NP who see’s primary care clients just for UTI treatment and need to charge \$10 for the Urinalysis, you will choose UA from the regular lab code choices.
4. Q3523 CYTOPATH, GYN 1 is a Quest Conventional Pap Smear and had been added.
5. FOB has been added for Fecal Occult Blood, however if you order it and the client does not return with the specimen, it **WILL** show in the lab page as an outstanding unresolved lab! Some may choose to **wait and order** this through the lab when the client returns with the specimen.
6. Other Quest tests added are Q483 (Glucose Serum), Q899 (TSH), Q470 (FSH)
7. If you have been using any other codes for your Chlamydia/GC swab and/or urine, you will no longer be using them. The choice is CHL/GCSW or CHL/GCUR
8. State hepatitis labs will be HEPA-S, HEPB-S, and HEPC-S.
9. We realize that the STD module pulls several of the tests and cultures with a different code entirely into the lab page. These STD labs “stand on their own” as is. There is no way to change this module and M&M is in the process of updating this module. I will be doing a cheat sheet for the STD module lab codes, for reference and will send it as soon as possible so you can recognize them as such.
